

READING TIPS **FOR** *Families*

1. Talk, Sing, and Share Stories

Hearing and using language helps our brains build a strong foundation for reading.

2. Play with Letters and Sounds

Draw letters in the snow or sand. Ask, "What sounds do these letters make?"

3. Read Together

Make it a special time. Take turns. Try different types of books.

4. Ask Questions

What do you think will happen? What was your favorite part?
